MaeTec Power gets FAA contract for battery work

MaeTec Power Inc. is included in a contract from the Federal Aviation Administration for up to \$8 million to help supply and replace battery strings at sites throughout the United States, the Perinton-based company announced.

The work will be done at 2,200 General National Air Space facilities, including in Alaska and Hawaii, and in Puerto Rico and Guam, the company said.

MaeTec is one of the vendors selected to provide the batteries, including shipping services, recycle and disposal services, and installation, company officials said.

In 2009, the company was awarded a battery replacement contract totaling \$17.5 million for five years for battery replacements at air traffic control centers nationwide.
